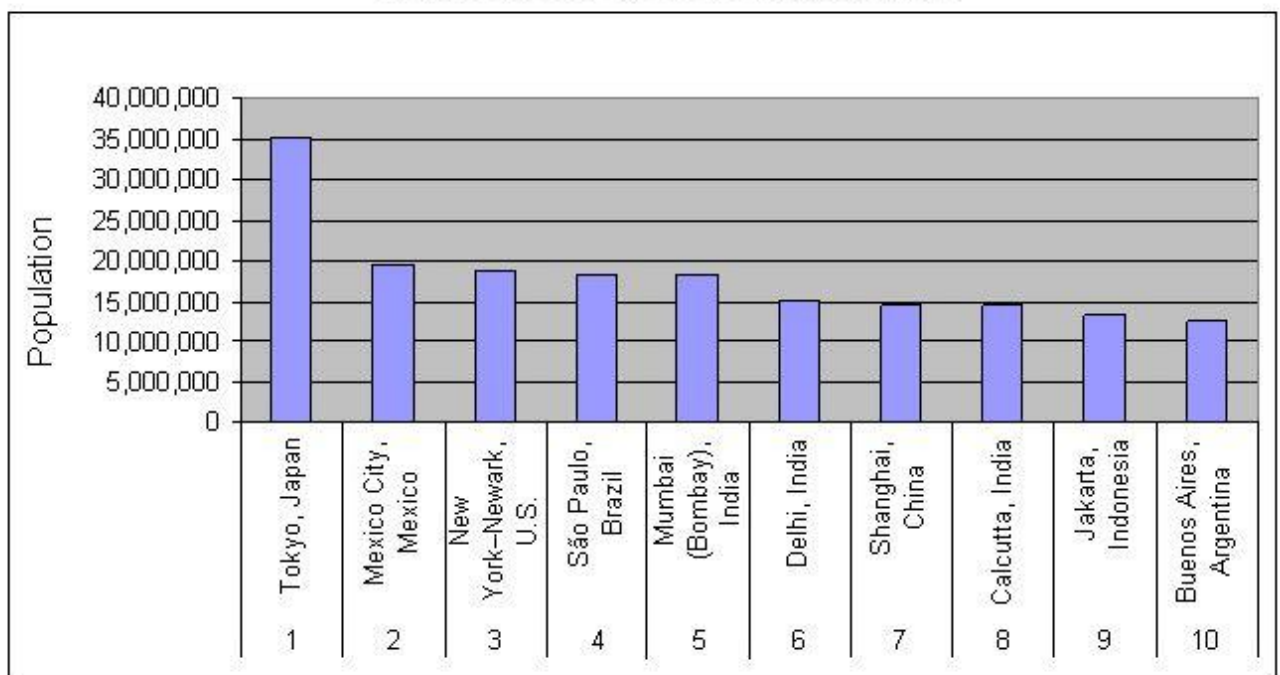

Composition of the Sun (% components)

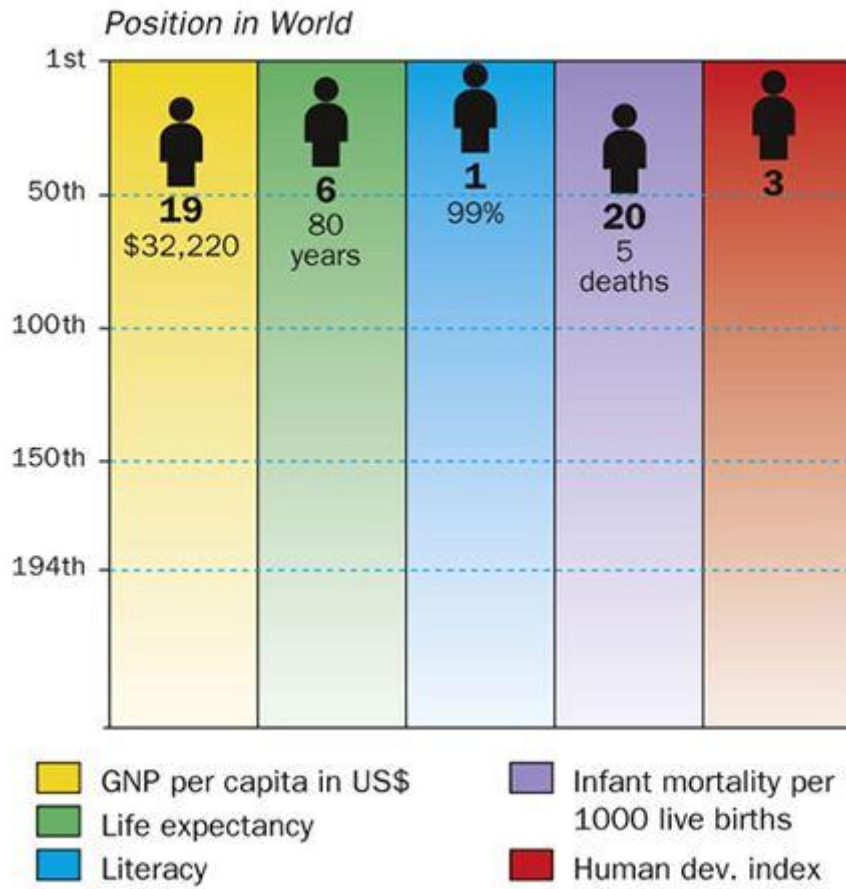




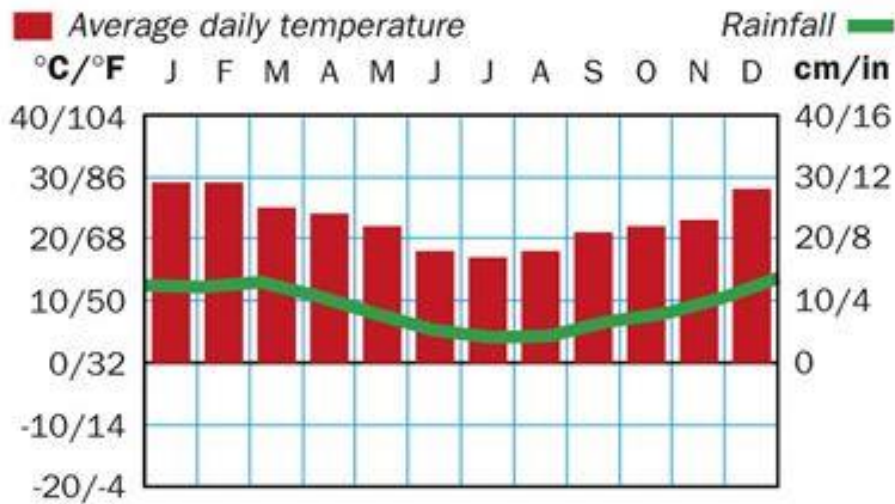
Map of Azerbaijan

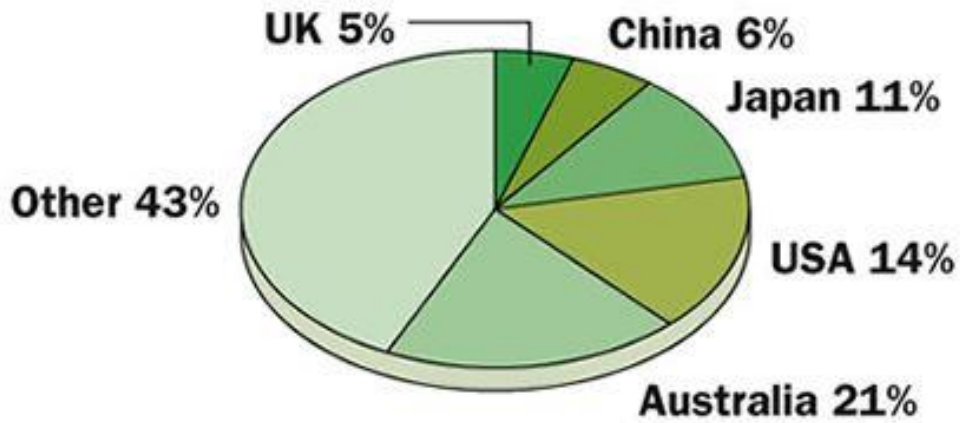
Composition of the Finnish Parliament

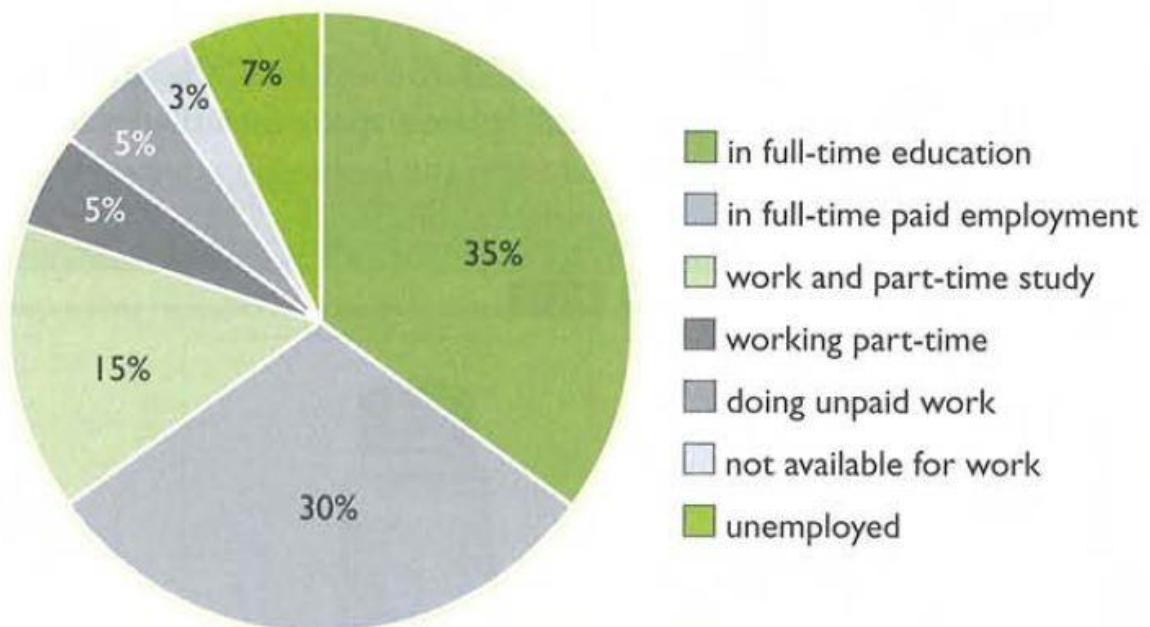


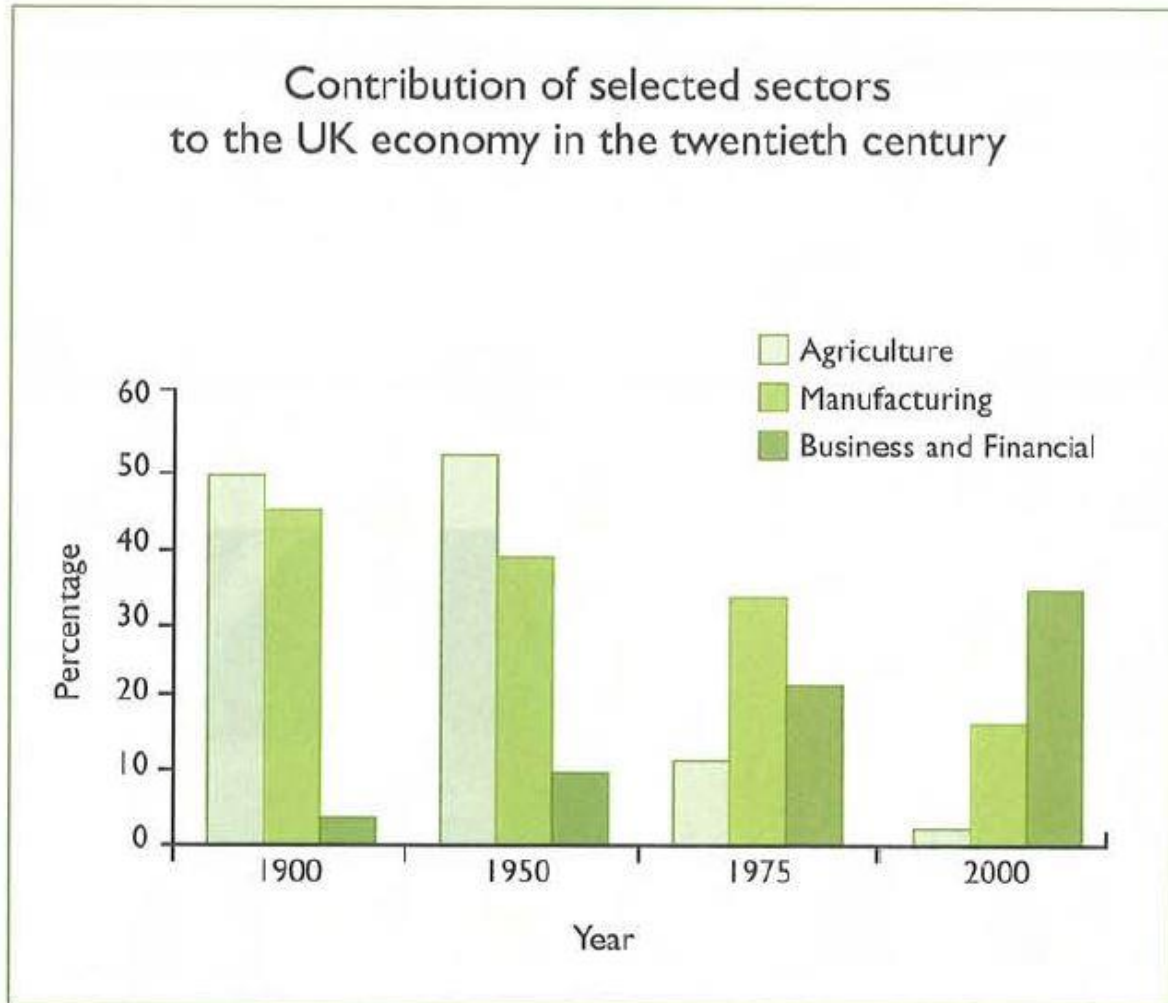


Export of motorcycles from Japan Last calendar year, by region (%)

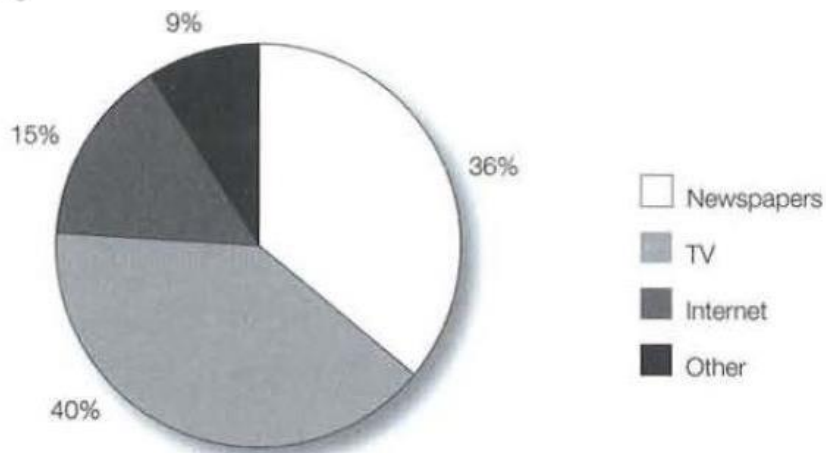

Employment of Physics graduates one year after graduation

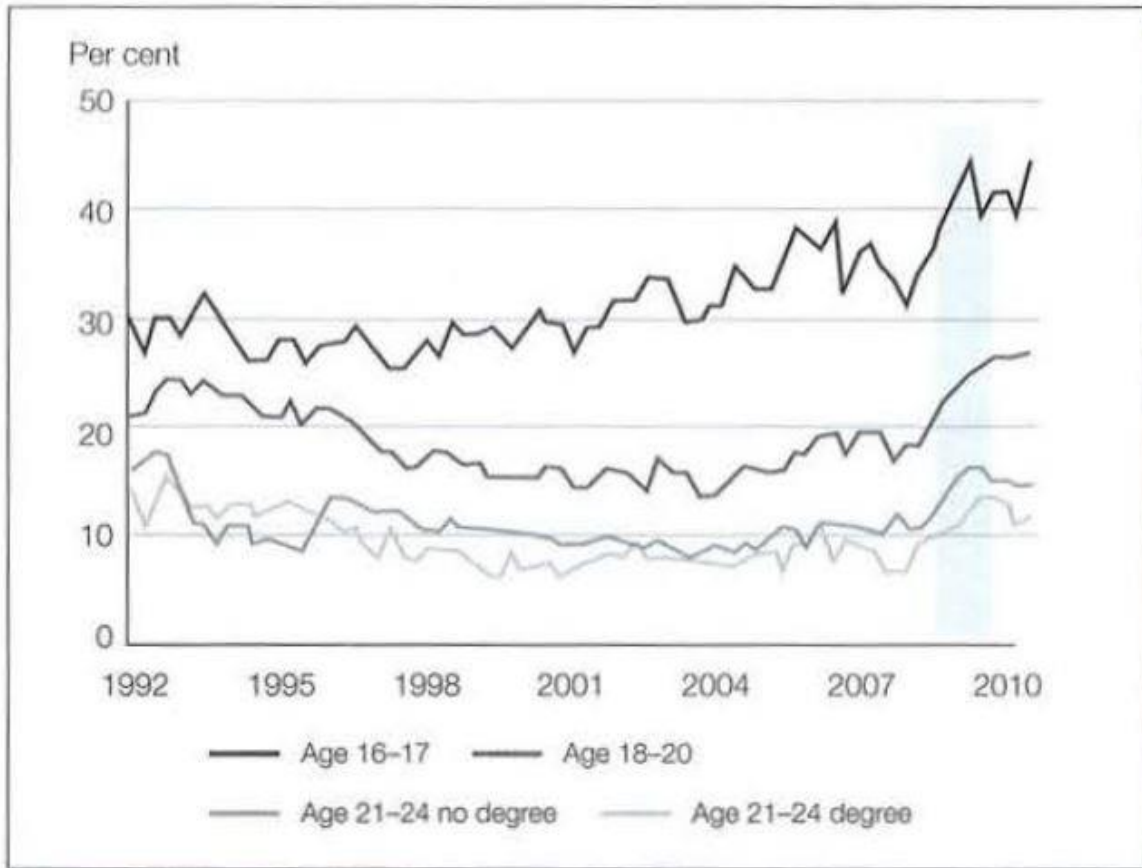




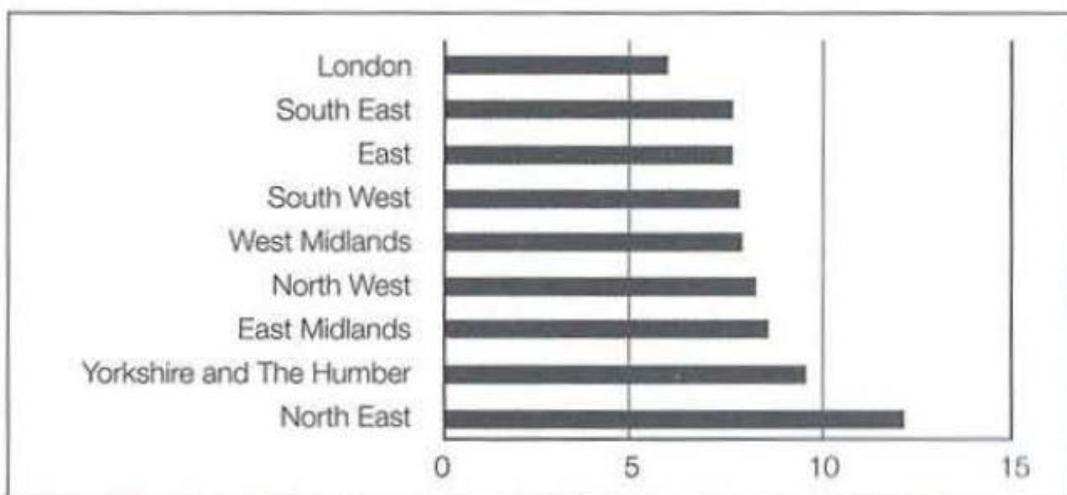

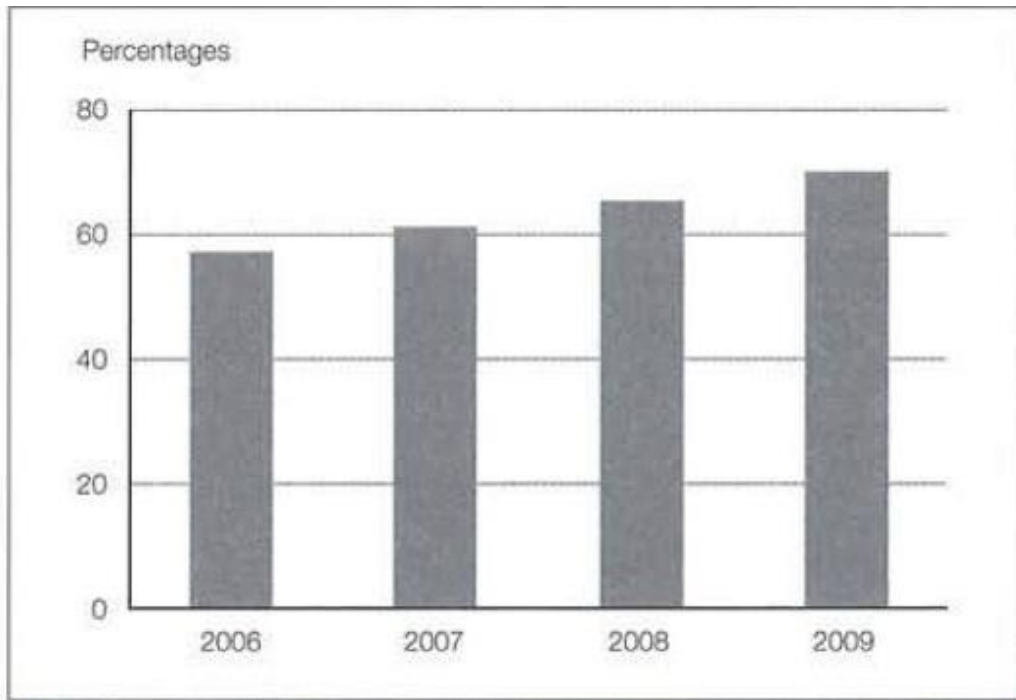

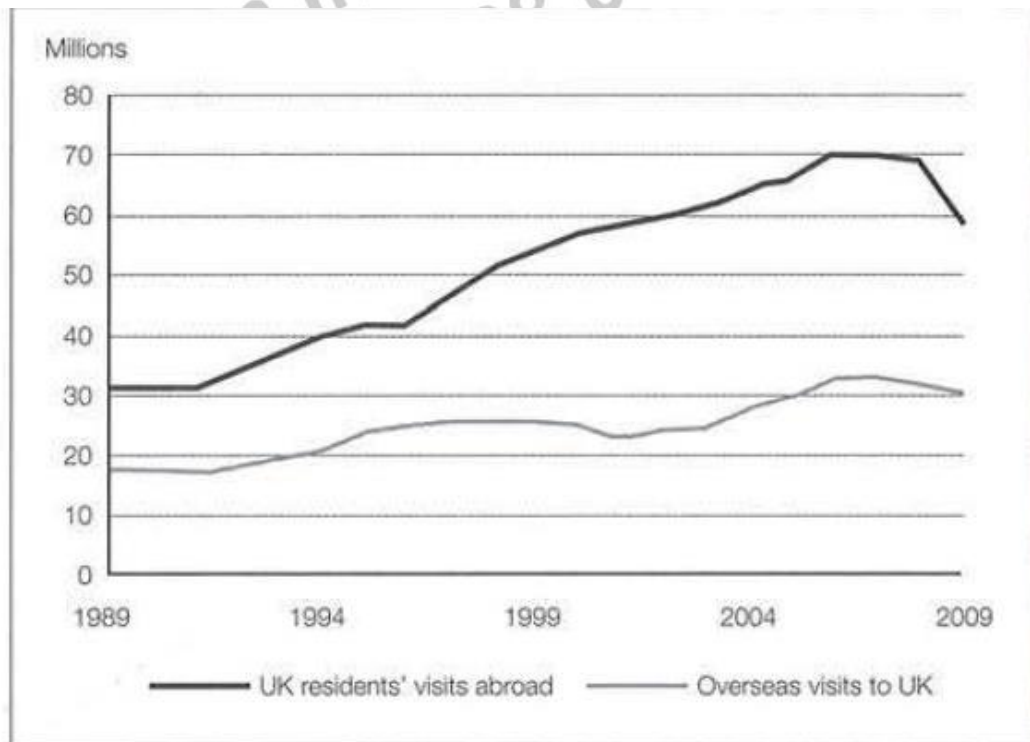
Unemployment rates by age and qualification



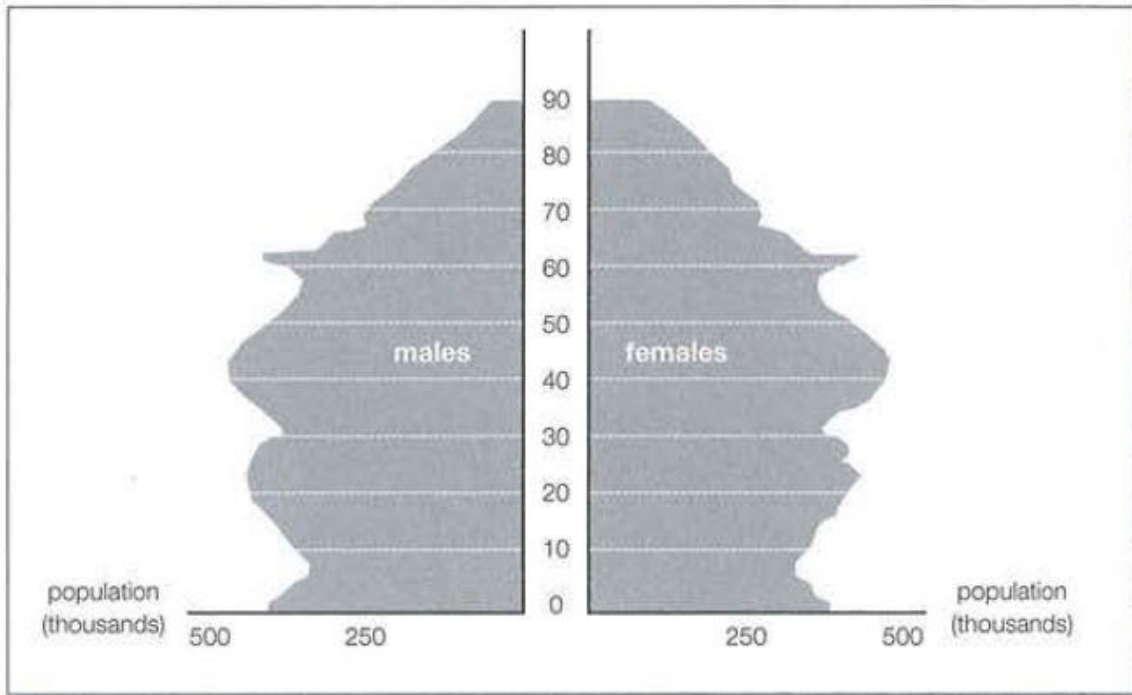
Carbon dioxide emissions per resident, 2008 (Tonnes)



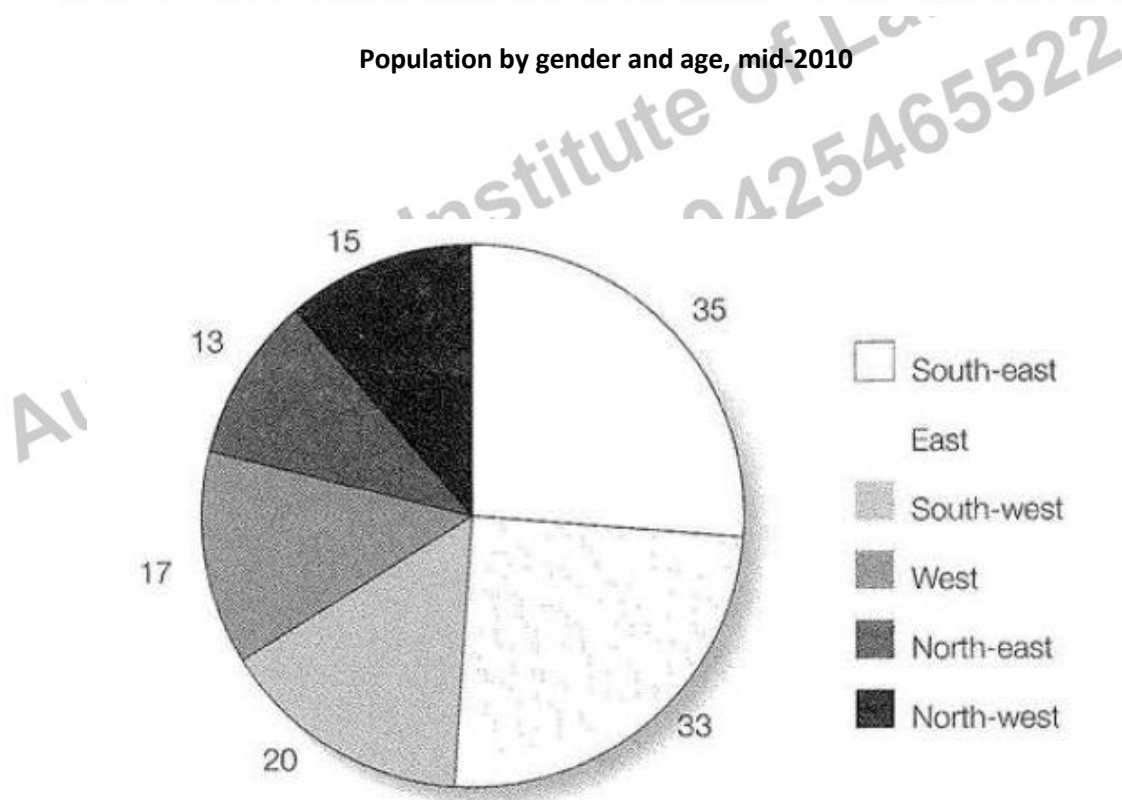
Households with an access to the Internet, UK



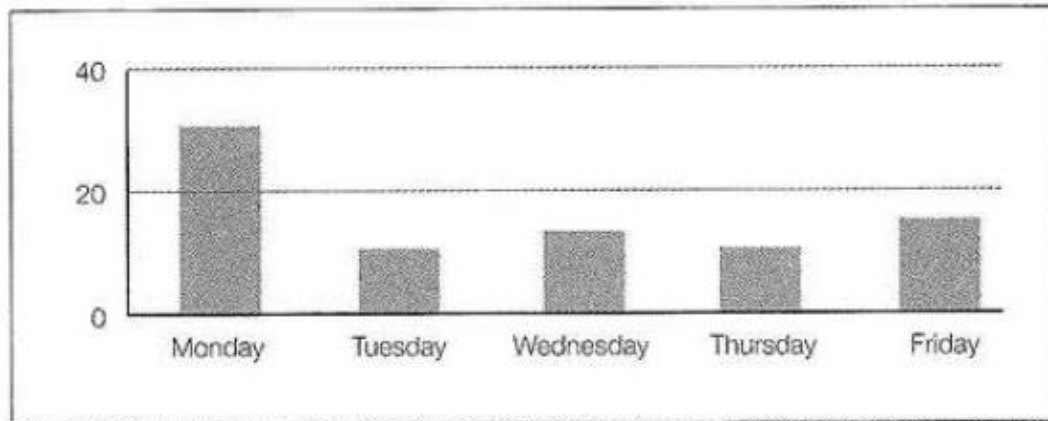
Overseas residents' visit to the UK and UK residents' visits abroad



Population by gender and age, mid-2010



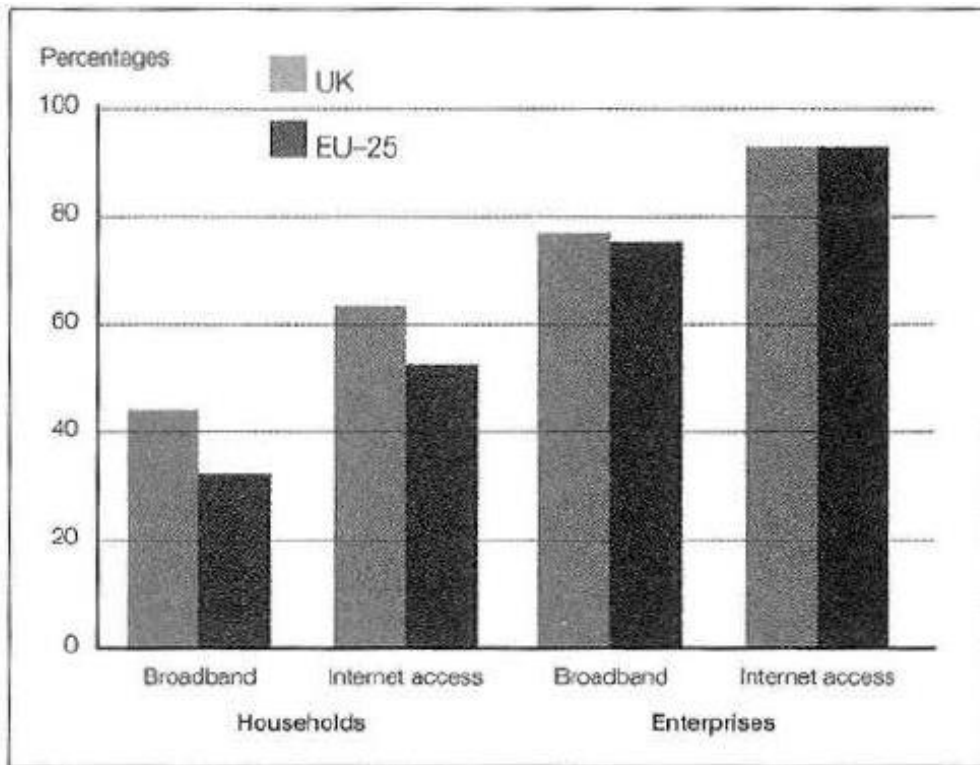
Amount of time on average spent in consultation with local doctor (GP) (hr/years)



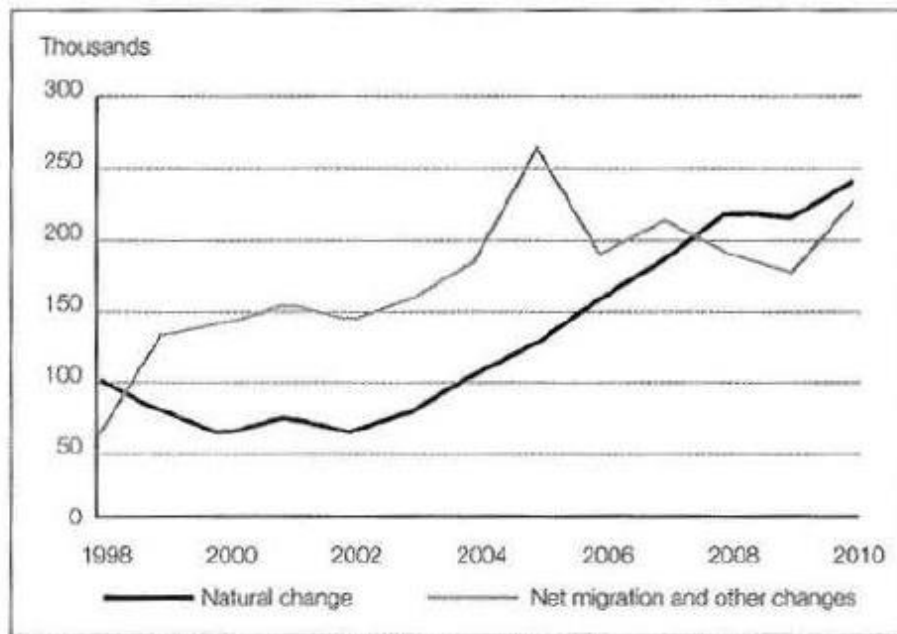

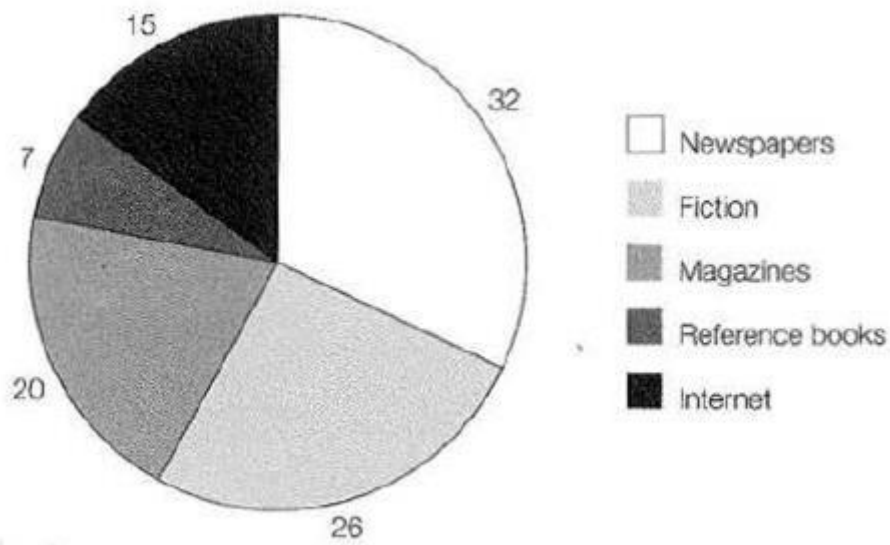
Time spent on main activities by sex, 2005, GB



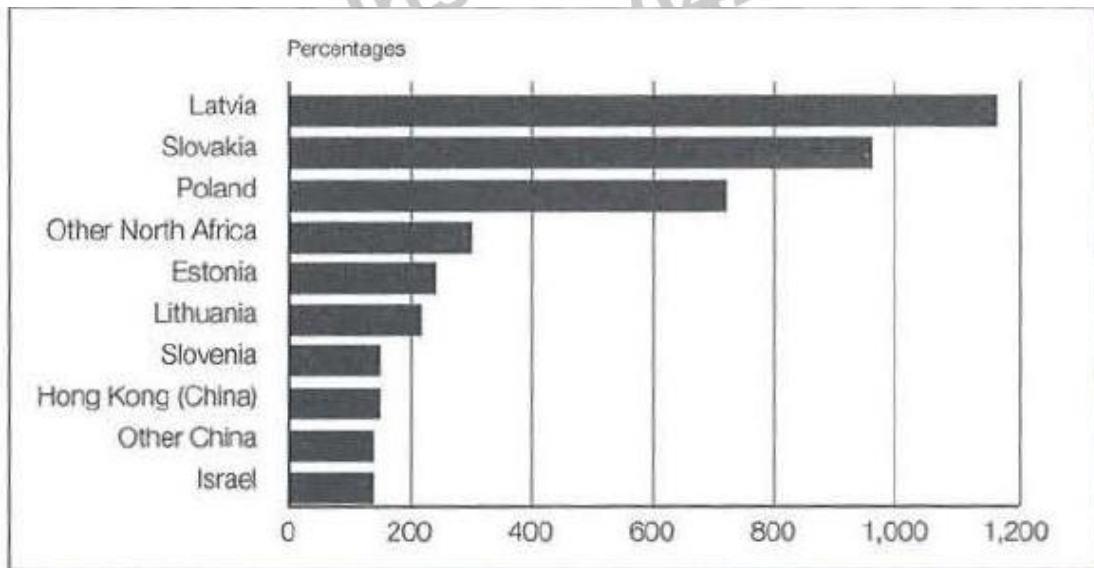
Internet access and broadband connections: by households and enterprises, 2006



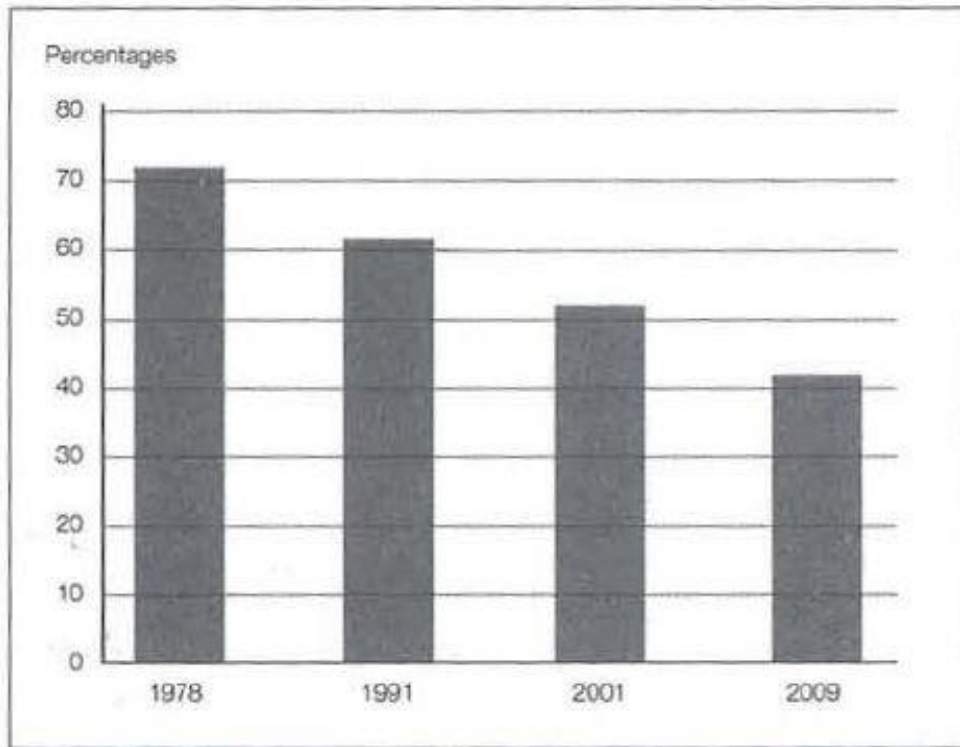
Components of population change, United Kingdom, mid-1998 to mid-2010.



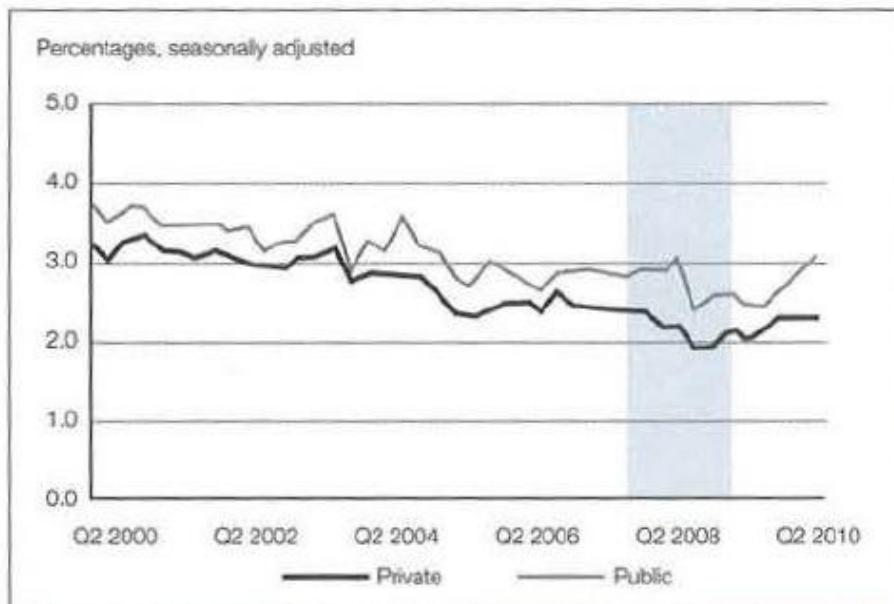
How much of their reading time do students spend on different forms of reading?



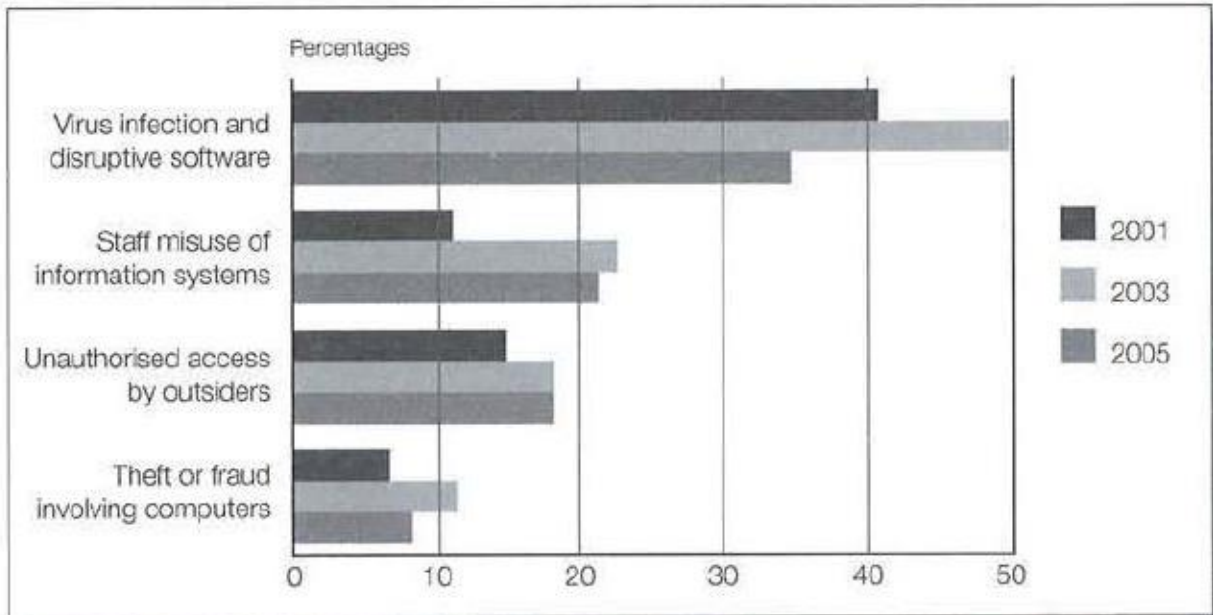
Holiday destinations that have shown the largest percentage growth, 2003 to 2007, UK residents



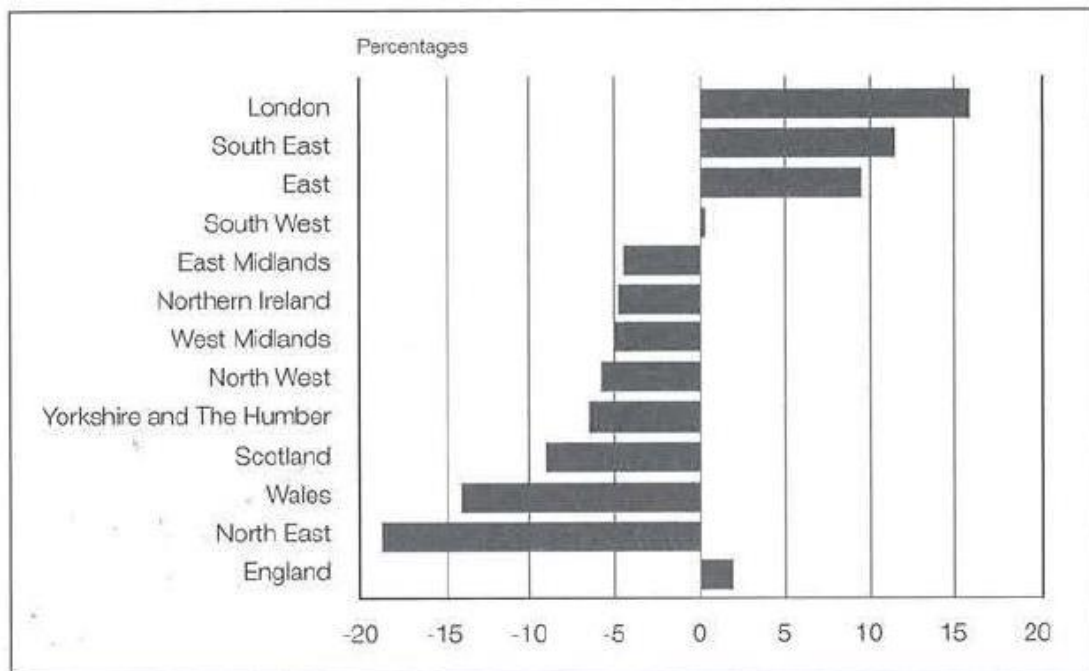
Daily newspaper readership



Public and private sector sickness rates, 2000-2010 UK



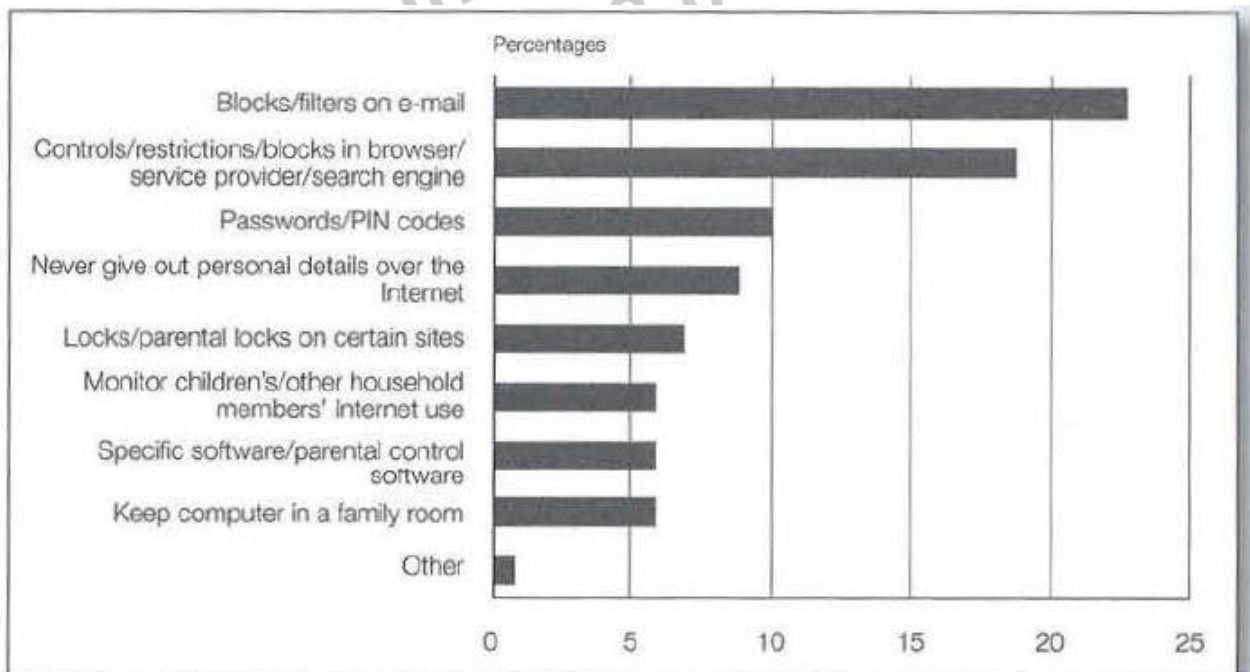
Businesses suffering malicious e-security incident: by type of incident, UK



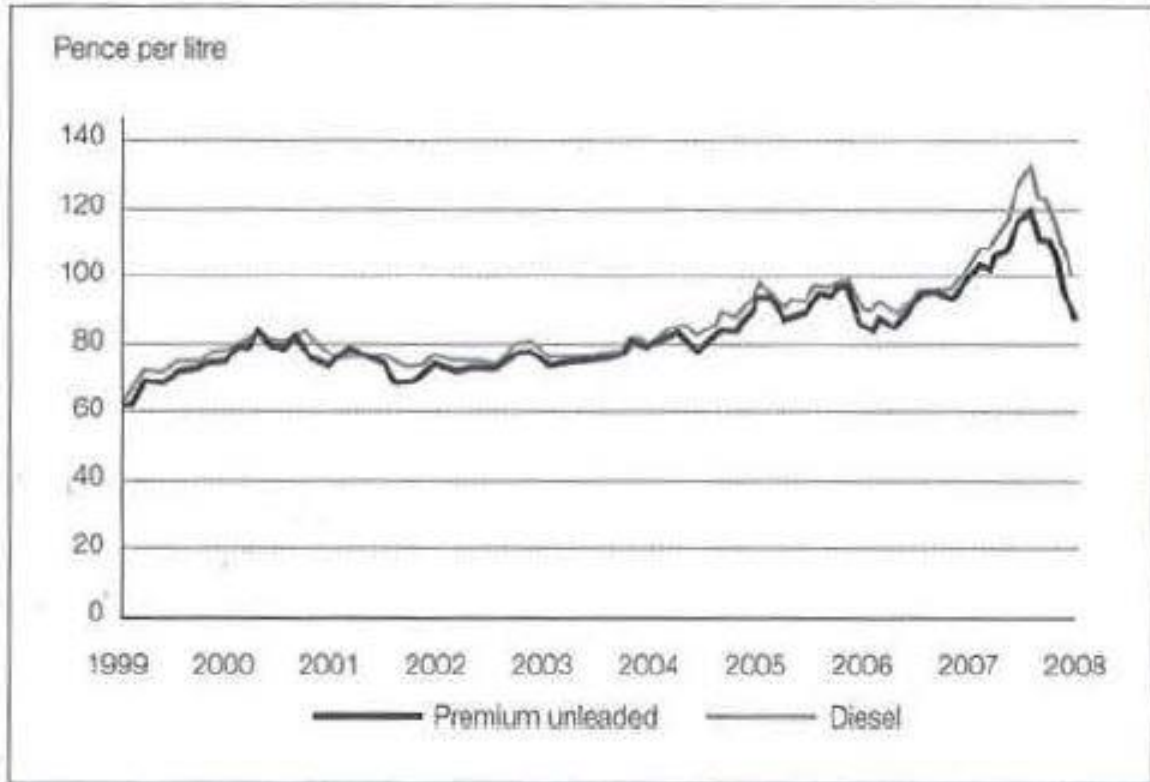
Average weekly household expenditure in relation to the UK average, 2003/04 to 2005/06

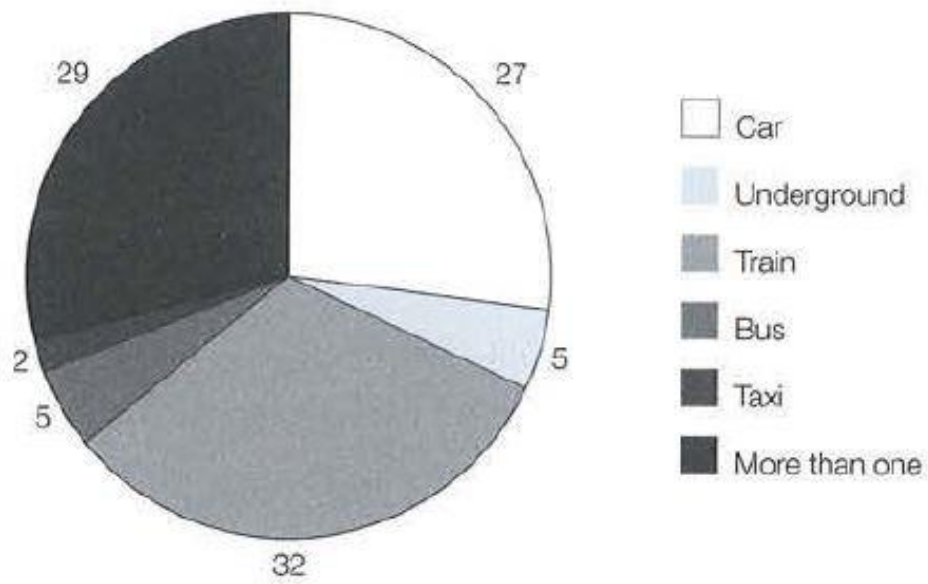

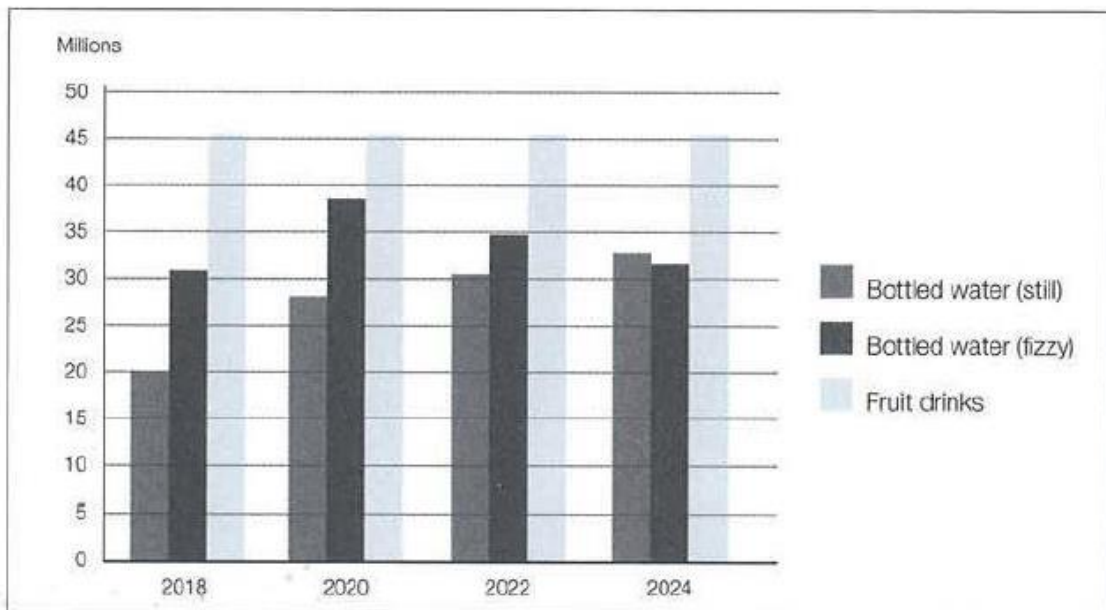
Premium unleaded petrol and diesel pump prices, UK

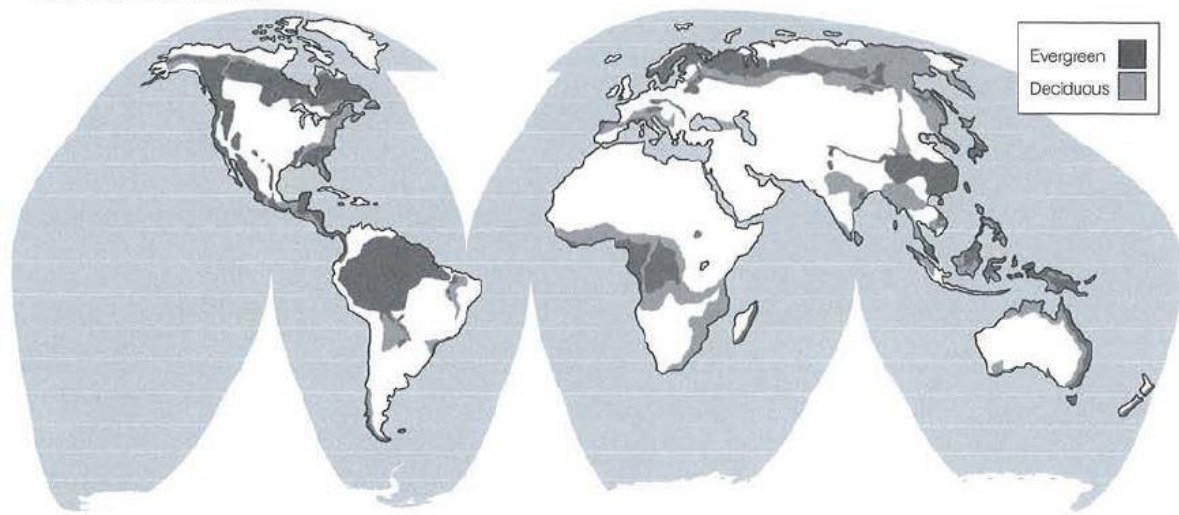


Survey of means of transport used by commuters living outside the city
